The FDA has expanded its recall of foods produced at the Peanut Corporation of America plant in Georgia to include the Peanut Corporation of America plant in Texas. Because Peanut Corporation of America has declared bankruptcy, **the only way to know if you have a product that has been recalled is to go to the FDA web site, www.fda.gov** .

There are now more than 2100 products that have been recalled. The number of illnesses from the recalled products has risen to 677. Additional cases of illness continue to be reported. For information on *Salmonella* including symptoms and control, please see <http://www.cdc.gov/salmonella/> .
